Chinese-born Australian pianist Oliver She was raised in Brisbane, where he received his AMEB Licentiate Diploma during his school years. He completed undergraduate studies with Max Olding and Pamela Page at the University of Queensland, graduating with first-class Honours. He was prize winner in the ANU Chopin, Lev Vlassenko and Southern Highlands competitions, won the national ABC Young Performers Awards, and has made appearances at Parliament House, the Sydney Opera House, Melbourne Recital Centre, and Arts Centre Brisbane and Gold Coast.

In 2015, Oliver graduated with a Master's from the Royal Northern College of Music, having studied with Graham Scott and generously supported by the F. W. Wright Award and the Australian Music Foundation. His accolades include winning the RNCM Beethoven, Recital and Concerto prizes, the London Beethoven Intercollegiate Competition, and the Brant International Competition in Birmingham, and performances in Birmingham, Nottingham, Bath, and with the RNCM symphony orchestra.

In addition to his solo pursuits, Oliver is a keen duo and chamber player, having performed a range of collaborative repertoire alongside various instrumentalists and vocalists over the years. He is currently a Junior Fellow staff accompanist at the RNCM.
